SUPPLY LIST FOR DRAWING WITH INK WORKSHOP

One container Sumi or India ink (black); 2 oz or larger.

Paper:

One 18 x 24" pad of watercolor paper, or you may buy individual sheets to experiment with varying textures. (For instance, 20x 24" sheets of Arches, hot press for smoother texture, cold press for rougher texture. The weight should be 90 lb or higher. You can also try bristol board for a very smooth surface. Some experimenting will help you find what you like working with.)

Pens:

One bamboo pen

One dip pen with drawing nib, such as Speedball 513EF

Brushes:

2 round brushes, one small (size 6), one larger (size 12), sable or soft synthetic watercolor brush

1-2 flat wash brushes, ranging from ½ inch to 2 inches

*1 bamboo Sumi brush, size 10

One small tube of white gouache

Artist's tape

Paper towels or rags

Sponge:

Natural sponge or common household sponge

3-4 small cups for diluting ink; 1 larger cup for rinsing brushes

Sketchbook or scrap paper
